

Tuition and Fees

New Student Registration

Registration for new students (including siblings of presently enrolled students) will take place from February 21-25, 2011. All fees must be paid at the time of acceptance in order to put a child's name on the roster for the next school year. The Principal will be available for interviews with parents and students that week.

Registration Fees

The following fees are due at the time of registration and are non-refundable as well as non-transferable. A place will not be held for a student unless these fees are paid in full.

Catholic/Contributing

\$165 **Oldest** or **only** child

\$150 **Each additional** child in family

Catholic (Non-contributing) or Non-Catholic

\$165 **Oldest** or **only** child

\$150 **Each additional** child in family

\$300 Parish support fee **per student**

Active, Registered, Supporting Member of St. Cletus Parish

To be considered an active, registered, supporting member of the parish, a family must contribute \$10 weekly to St. Cletus Church by December 31, 2010, for a total of \$520 per year. Family members should also participate in the life of the parish and support parish activities.

An approval form for in-parish tuition from St. Cletus Church MUST accompany your registration form. Forms can be obtained from the parish office between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. On Wednesday, February 16, 2010, the parish office will remain open until 6:30 P.M. A Catholic family residing in a parish without a school, or in a parish with a school that has no openings at the time of registration, may apply to their pastor for a voucher for the parish support fee.
