Pre-Kindergarten 3 and 4

Recognition of letters, numbers, shapes, colors, and sounds is stressed in imaginative and varied ways by experienced and compassionate teachers and assistants. Kindergarten

The full day Kindergarten program at St. Cletus continues the work started in Pre K and further develops the students' skills in listening, speaking, reading, writing, and mathematics. Phonetic awareness, handwriting practice, learning vowel and consonant sounds, and letter combinations help to create fluent readers and fledgling writers. Students rotate through various centers to reinforce newly learned skills and enjoy enrichment classes of P.E., music, computer, and social living. Daily Religion class and weekly Mass with their Seventh-grade buddies enhance their understanding of God's world and their place in it. Devoted, experienced teachers also plan off-campus field trips, as well as many unique educational experiences that celebrate the seasons, feast days and holidays of the school year.
